Discussion Questions | October 19, 2025

Getting Started

1. From the sermon or your direct reading of Genesis 3:1-7; James 4:6; Philippians 2:1-11, What surprised, encouraged, or challenged you?

Going Deeper Prayer Project

Part 1 — Seeing Pride for What It Is (about 20 min)

Read slowly Genesis 3:1–7. Let the scene come alive. Ask yourself and the Lord:

- Where am I still reaching for control?
- Where do I want to be noticed, to define things for myself?
- What does it look like when I try to "be like God" in my own small kingdom?

Sit with what surfaces. Don't hurry to fix it. Just name it before Him.If you sense resistance, stay there a moment. Pride often hides behind good intentions.

Part 2 — Letting Grace Interrupt (about 20 min)

Read James 4:6 and whisper it aloud: "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

Ask the Lord:

- Where has His mercy been opposing me lately? not to crush me, but to wake me?
- What humbling experience has actually been grace in disguise?
- Can I receive that as His love, not His rejection?

Then imagine laying down your crown before Him—every role, title, success, or wound you've used to prove your worth.

Part 3 — Gazing on Christ's Humility (about 15 min)

Read Philippians 2:5–11 slowly, maybe twice. Picture Jesus descending—emptying Himself, serving, obeying, dying, then being lifted up.

Ask:

- Where might I join Him in that downward way this week?
- What small act of humility could I embrace—a hidden service, a gentle word, a quiet surrender?
- What would it look like to live free from needing to be seen?

End by simply resting in His presence. No words needed—just awareness that He is near, and His humility is your healing.
